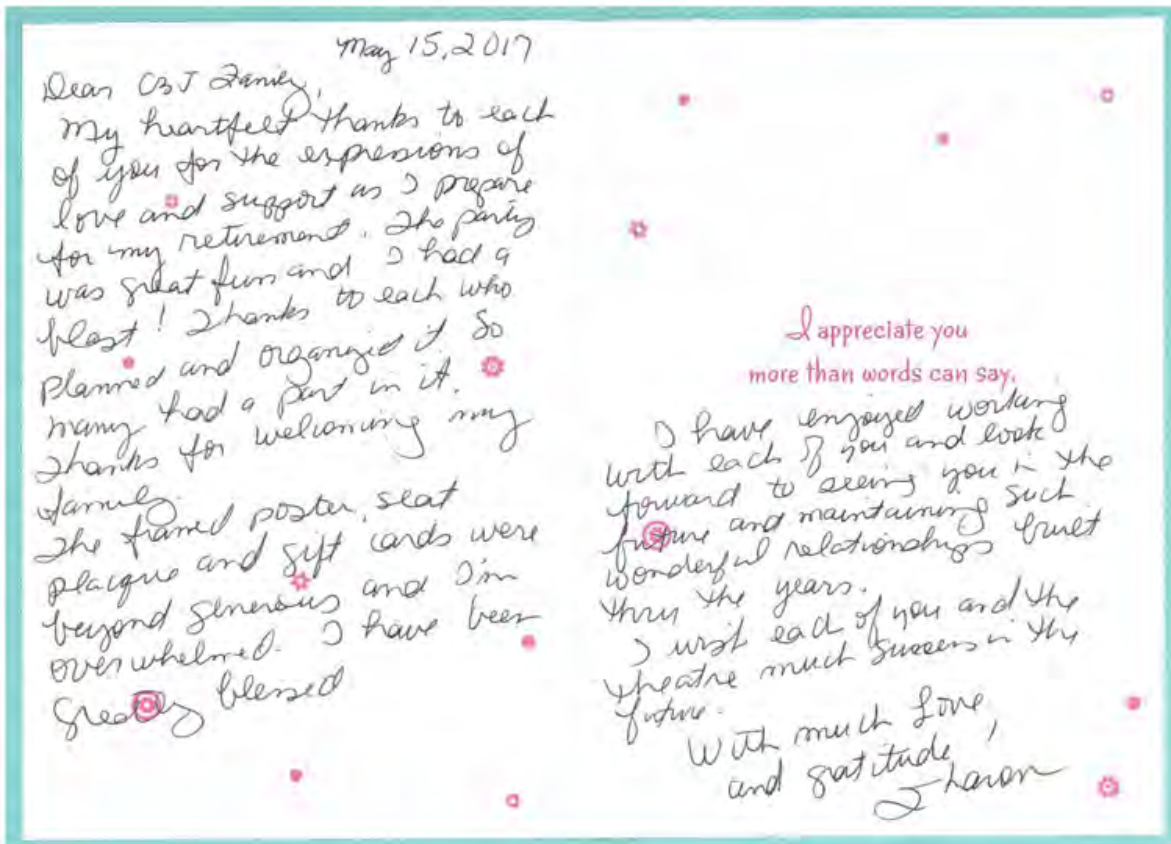

UT Summer Projects

Please note that Phase 2 of the Volunteer Blvd project will begin the first of June. This second phase will itself have two segments. The first will concentrate on (and thus close) the portion from Peyton Manning Pass to Lake Loudoun Boulevard. Concurrently the portion from Lake Loudoun to Pat Head Summitt Street will start on the north side, and traffic will be condensed to one lane in each direction on the

south side. Phase 2 is expected to be completed August, as is the steam line project from the Pedestrian walkway to Melrose Hall. Circle Park will be completely closed. Circle Park will reopen before football season begins.
