In order to be considered for a Joyce Brakebill Theatre Scholarship, you must participate in an audition or an interview with one of the University of Tennessee theatre faculty.

If you are primarily interested in performance, you should prepare a short monologue that highlights your acting ability. If you are also a singer, we ask that you prepare 16-32 bars of a song from the musical theatre cannon.

If you are primarily interested in technology or design, you will have a brief interview with one of the design faculty. If you have a portfolio, pictures of productions you have worked on, or drawings/renderings that you have created, you should bring those to your interview. (If you don't that's fine too.)

Your audition/interview can take place either before or after you complete your scholarship application.

If you have not yet auditioned, the theatre department will contact you about scheduling an audition once your scholarship application and UT application have been received.

Audition/interviews can take place at the following times:

- During a visit to the University of Tennessee, Knoxville (please contact the department to schedule your audition/interview BEFORE coming to campus, so that we can assure a faculty member is available to meet with you.
- During the auditions at the Tennessee Theatre Association annual convention in October
- During the auditions at the South Eastern Theatre Conference (SETC) convention in March
- Via Skype or other video link.
